<u>NOTIFICATION</u> <u>ADMISSION TO B.PHARM (LATERAL ENTRY) COURSE- 2022</u> <u>FIRST PHASE ALLOTMENT PUBLISHED</u>

The First phase of Centralised Allotment for admission to the B. Pharm (Lateral Entry) Course in Government Pharmacy Colleges and Self Financing Pharmacy Colleges of the State for the year 2022 is published herewith on the website **www.cee.kerala.gov.in.** The allotment is based on the rank list from the online Entrance Examinations and the online options registered by the candidates within the stipulated time.

Candidates can access their homepage by entering their application number, and Password in the **'B.Pharm (LE) 2022 - Candidate Portal'** provided in the above website. Then, by clicking the menu item **'Allotment Result'**, candidates can view the allotment result. If the candidate gets an allotment in a college, it is necessary to download a print out of their allotment memo. The details, such as the candidate's name, Roll number, allotment details, tuition fees etc., are available in the allotment memo. The allotment memo and data sheet will be available on the home page from **21.03.2023** onwards. Candidates can log into their Home Page and then click the Menu Item **'Data Sheet'** to download the Data Sheet.

Candidates who receive allotment should take admission at the concerned colleges from **22.03.2023 to 25.03.2023** before **3.00 PM** along with the allotment memo and original documents specified in Clause.7.3.8 of the Prospectus. They should remit the complete fees as per the concerned Government Order to the allotted college authorities at the time of admission. All the College Principals should approve and submit the list of admitted candidates through the Online Admission Management

System (OAMS) before **4.00 PM** on **25.03.2023**.

The candidates, who do not join the college within the specified time will lose their present allotment and also their higher order options.

Candidates who have claimed SC/ST reservation and whose caste status is under scrutiny by KIRTADS or the Government have been provisionally considered for allotment. The allotment/admission, if any, of such candidates shall be purely provisional and subject to final verification of their caste status.
