ADMISSION TO B.PHARM (LATERAL ENTRY) COURSE-2025 **FIRST PHASE ALLOTMENT PUBLISHED**

The First Phase Centralised Allotment for admission to B.Pharm (Lateral Entry) Course in Government Pharmacy Colleges and Self Financing Pharmacy Colleges of the State for the year 2025 has been published on the website **www.cee.kerala.gov.in**. The allotment is based on the option submitted online by the candidates who have been included in the Rank list based on the entrance examination for admission to B.Pharm Lateral Entry – 2025 and Category lists prepared by the CEE.

Candidates can access their homepage by entering their application number, and Password in the '**B.Pharm (LE) 2025 - Candidate Portal**' provided in the website. By clicking the menu '**Allotment Result**', candidates can view the allotment result. If the candidate gets an allotment in a college, it is necessary to download the print out of the Allotment Memo and Data Sheet. The details, such as candidate's name, Roll number, allotment details, tuition fees etc. are available in the Allotment Memo. Candidates can log into their Home Page and then click the Menu '**Data Sheet**' for downloading the Data Sheet.

Candidates who receive allotment should take admission at the allotted colleges from **11.12.2025 to 15.12.2025 before 4.00 PM (except on holidays)** along with the Allotment Memo and original documents specified in Clause 7.3.8 of the Prospectus. They should remit the complete fees to the allotted college authorities at the time of admission. All the College Principals should approve and submit the list of admitted candidates through Online Admission Management System (OAMS) before **5.00 PM on 15.12.2025**.

The candidates, who do not join the college within the specified time, will lose their present allotment and also the higher order options.
