SECOND PHASE ALLOTMENT TO B.PHARM (LATERALENTRY) COURSE-2025 FACILITY FOR ONLINE OPTION CONFIRMATION

The second phase Centralised Allotment Process for admission to B.Pharm (LE) Course in the Government Pharmacy Colleges and Private Self- financing Pharmacy Colleges of the State for the year 2025-26 commences on 16.12.2025. Candidates who are having valid options and who are willing to participate in the second allotment have to log in to his/her Home page on the website, www.cee.kerala.gov.in, and **confirm** their options by clicking the '**Confirm button**' accessible through the link '**Option Registration**'. Thereafter, the options carried over from the previous phase will become accessible and the candidates can delete their unwanted options or alter their priority for existing options. If a candidate does not confirm the higher order options by clicking the '**Confirm**' button available in his/her Home page, his/her higher order options will not be considered for seat allotment. However, the existing allotment shall be retained if the candidate has taken admission. The facility for online option confirmation/deletion/rearrangement will be available on the website www.cee.kerala.gov.in from **16.12.2025 to 19.12.2025, 10.00 AM**. Those who do not confirm their options online within the stipulated time will not be considered for this phase of allotment. Tentative schedule for the allotment is given below.

16.12.2025	Website opens for Option Confirmation
19.12.2025, 10 AM	Facility for option confirmation ends
19.12.2025	Provisional Allotment
20.12.2025	Final Allotment
22.12.2025 to 24.12.2025, 4 PM	Joining at allotted colleges after paying the fees/balance fee (if applicable) as shown in the Allotment Memo.
24.12.2025, 5 PM	OAMS updation by the college authorities

The annual tuition fee, other fees and the deposits (if applicable) should be remitted in the allotted colleges at the time of admission. SC/ST/OEC/Children of Fisherman/inmates of Sri Chithra Home, Nirbhaya Home and Juvenile Home candidates are exempted from payment of fees. Candidates who receive allotment should have attained the eligibility for admission as per Clause 4 of the Prospectus at the time of admission. Candidates are advised not to retain unnecessary options to colleges where they do not wish to join, if allotted.
