#### **Re-opening of application submission facility following lowering of the minimum qualifying percentile**

The NEET-PG-2025 minimum qualifying percentile have been lowered by the National Board of Examinations in accordance with the directions of the Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, Govt. of India vide letter No. U-12021/11/2025-MEC (FTS- 8363852) dated 09.01.2026, as detailed in the table below:

In accordance with the same online application submission facility based on revised minimum qualifying criteria for DNB (Post MBBS) 2025 has been re-opened, and will remain open **till 18.01.2026, 11.59 PM**. In this phase of online application submission, NEET qualified candidates who have not registered earlier can also apply.
