**AYURVEDA/HOMOEOPATHY/SIDDHA/UNANI/PHARMACY/MEDICAL ALLIED COURSES-**  
**2023- FACILITY MADE AVAILABLE**

The activities related to the third phase allotment to MBBS/BDS courses and first phase allotment to other Medical & Medical Allied Courses (BAMS, BSMS, BHMS, BUMS, BSc.(Hons.) Agri., BSc.(Hons.) Forestry, BSc.(Hons.) Co-Operation & Banking, BSc.(Hons.) Climate Change & Environmental Science, B.Tech. Biotechnology, BVSc. & AH, BFSc) and B.pharm courses for the State Quota Seats for the academic year 2023-24 are started.

**MBBS, BDS COURSES**

**Online Option Confirmation is mandatory**

Those Candidates who want their higher order options in MBBS/BDS courses to be considered in the third phase of allotment, shall have to log into their Home page and confirm their options by clicking the ‘**confirm**’ button available therein. After Online Option confirmation, the candidates can re-arrange their higher order options/ delete the unwanted options or add newly added courses, if any, from **07.09.2023 to 11.09.2023 3.00 PM**, through the website **www.cee.kerala.gov.in**. The allotment to MBBS seats in Karuna Medical College, Palakkad will also be done in this phase (see Govt.Order given in the website). **Online option confirmation is mandatory for those who have got admission and those who have no allotment as per the previous phase allotments, to consider them in the third phase allotment.** If the candidate does not confirm his/her options the existing admission as per the second phase allotment shall be retained.

On the basis of options received up to **3.00 PM on 11.09.2023** the third phase allotment to MBBS/BDS courses will be published in the website **www.cee.kerala.gov.in** on **14.09.2023**. Candidates who receives allotment in this phase shall have to take a printout of their allotment memo and remit the fee/balance fee (if applicable) payable to the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations by way of online payment or through any of the Head Post Offices in Kerala. The list of Post Offices having facility for fee payment is available in the website. After remitting the fee/balance fee (if applicable), the candidates should join the course/college allotted.

**FEES**

The details of fee for the MBBS/BDS courses, in various colleges is available in the website. As the fee for 2023-24 academic year is not yet fixed in Self Financing Medical/Dental colleges, those candidates who get allotment in Self Financing colleges should provisionally pay the fee fixed for 2022-23 academic year and they have to pay the balance fees in case if the fee to be fixed by the Admission Supervisory Committee/Government/Hon'ble High Court for the academic year 2023-24 is going to be higher than that of 2022-23 for these colleges.

**TOKEN FEES**

- Those candidates who gets allotment to MBBS courses in Self-financing colleges should pay an amount of Rs.1 lakh and those candidates who gets allotment to NRI quota seats should remit fee of Rs.5 lakhs to the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations.
- Those candidates who gets allotment to BDS course (including NRI quota seats) should pay an amount of Rs.1 lakh to the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations.
- Those candidates who gets allotment to Government Medical/Dental courses should pay the complete fee to Commissioner for Entrance Examinations.

Candidates allotted under SC/ST/OEC/Fishermen category and those having benefits as per G.O((MS)25/2005/SCSTDD, dated: 20.06.2005 and G.O(MS)10/2014/BCDD, dated 23.05.2014, and those candidates from Sreechitra Home, Juvenile Home, Nirbhaya Home should not pay the token fee. However, if such candidates are allotted under Minority/NRI quota seats in Self-Financing Medical/Dental colleges, they will have to remit the token fee as prescribed above and they will not be eligible for any fee concession.

**Note:**

1. Candidates are advised to file options to the courses/colleges to which they are sure to join and continue studies if allotted, at the time of registration of options.
2. If NMC/MCC issues directives that the Third Round All India Quota allotted/admitted candidates become ineligible for Third Round State Quota counseling and if the list of such candidates are

shared by the NMC/MCC, the options of such candidates will not be considered for third round allotment in the State, i.e., they become ineligible for participating in the third round.

3. Those candidates who wish to vacate the seats joined through Phase I & Phase II can exit the seat forfeiting the Option Registration fees on or before 11.09.2023, 11 AM. But such candidates will not be considered for further rounds of Centralised Allotment Process except in Stray vacancy allotment.

Vacancy in MBBS/BDS course if any exists after the third round allotment will be filled up through Stray Vacancy Allotment. The details of Stray Vacancy Allotment will be published later.

The first phase of Centralised Allotment Process to the Kerala Ayurveda/ Homoeopathy /Siddha/Unani /Pharmacy/Agriculture/Veterinary/Forestry/Fisheries/Co- Operation & Banking/ Climate change & Environmental Science/B.Tech Biotechnology courses for the year 2023 is commenced on **07.09.2023**. Those candidates who are included in the Ayurveda and Medical rank lists published by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations and who are eligible for such courses as per NEET UG 2023 Information Bulletin can register options to Ayurveda, Medical/Medical Allied courses respectively and those candidates who are included in the Pharmacy rank list published by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations can register options to the Pharmacy course through the website [www.cee.kerala.gov.in](http://www.cee.kerala.gov.in) from **07.09.2023 to 11.09.2023, 3.00 PM**. Based on the options received up to **11.09.2023, 3.00 PM** the provisional allotment list will be published on **13.09.2023**. In this phase of allotment, candidates can register options to the following courses.

Allotment to 15% All India Quota Seats in Self Financing Ayurveda/Siddha/Unani colleges will be conducted by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations. The allotment to such seats will be conducted on the basis of the options registered in this phase as per the State Rank list for respective courses without considering domicile.

#### OPTION REGISTRATION FEE:

Those candidates who wish to register options will have to remit registration fee of Rs.5,000/- (Rupees Five Thousand Only) except for those who have remitted option registration fee for MBBS/ BDS, to the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations. The registration fee will be adjusted in the tuition fee of those candidates who take admission consequent on allotments. Candidates belonging to SC/ST/OEC category and those having benefits as per G.O.(Ms) No.25/2005/SCSTDD Dated 20.06.2005 and G.O.(Ms)No.10/2014/BCDD Dated 23.05.2014 and those candidates from Juvenile Home, Nirbhaya Home, Sree Chitra Home will have to remit Rs.500 /-(Rupees Five Hundred only) as Registration Fee. The Registration Fee of such candidates who take admission in the allotted college/course will be adjusted in the caution deposit. The registration fee of those candidates who do not get allotment will be refunded. (Bank account details shall have to be provided by the candidates for facilitating refund, if any.)

1. As the fee for the academic year 2023-24 is not yet fixed for the self-financing

Ayurveda/Siddha/Unani/Pharmacy colleges, those candidates who get allotment in these colleges should provisionally pay the fee fixed for the 2022-23 academic year, and they have to pay the balance fees in case the fee to be fixed by the Admission Supervisory Committee/Government/Hon'ble High Court for the academic year 2023- 24 is higher than that of 2022-23.

2. Allotment to self-financing Ayurveda/Unani colleges is subject to the affiliations from the Central Ayush Council (NCISM, New Delhi) and the Kerala University of Health Sciences (KUHS).
3. Candidates who get allotment to the Government/Self Financing colleges should pay the entire fee to the allotted college itself.
4. Candidates allotted under the SC/ST/OEC/Fishermen Category, as well as those with benefits under G.O. (MS) 25/2005/SCSTDD, dated: 20.06.2005, and G.O. (MS) 10/2014/BCDD, dated: 28.05.2014, and those from Sreechitra Home, Juvenile Home, and Nirbhaya Home, are exempted from paying tuition fees at the time of admission.

### **Special attention**

1. The allotment of those candidates who do not take admission within the stipulated time will be lost and such candidates will not be considered for further centralised allotment for the courses in the same stream. Candidates are advised to file options to the courses/colleges to which they are sure to join and continue studies if allotted.
2. The candidates whose results in the respective rank lists have been withheld due to various reasons can also register their online options for allotment. But the options submitted by such candidates will not be considered for allotment unless they produce the required documents to clear the defects and release their ranks before **12.09.2023, 11.00 AM.**
