FIRST PHASE ALLOTMENT TO AYURVEDA/HOMOEOPATHY/SIDDHA
/UNANI/ PHARMACY/MEDICAL ALLIED COURSES

The third phase allotment to MBBS/BDS Courses and the first phase centralised allotment to the Kerala Ayurveda / Homoeopathy / Siddha / Unani / Pharmacy / Agriculture / Veterinary / Forestry/ Fisheries / Co-Operation & Banking / Climate change & Environmental Science / B.Tech Biotechnology courses (Under Kerala Agricultural University) to the State quota seats in Government and Private Self-financing colleges in the state of Kerala for the academic year 2023-24 is published in the website of Commissioner for Entrance Examinations www.cee.kerala.gov.in. The Allotments has been published after addressing the valid complaints received within the specified time, against the provisional allotment lists published on 13.09.2023.

The allotted candidates can take printout of the allotment memo from **15.09.2023, 4.00pm** in the candidate portal. The details of allotment of a candidate such as **Name, Roll Number, Allotted Course, Allotted College, Category of Allotment, Fee details** etc. will be available on the home page of the candidate as well as in the Allotment Memo. The candidates should take a printout of the allotment memo from the Home Page. Candidates who receive an allotment should remit the fees as shown in the allotment memo to the allotted college and should join the allotted Course/College from **16.09.2023 to 20.09.2023, 4.00 PM**. If the fee already paid to the CEE in the previous allotment is higher than the fees of this allotment the excess amount will be refunded after the closure of the Centralized Allotment Process for all the courses.

Candidates who receive an allotment afresh should remit the fee to be paid to the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations as specified in the allotment memo at any of the Head Post Office in Kerala or by way of online payment on or before the date given above and should join the allotted course/college within the time specified with all the documents mentioned in the allotment memo and as per Prospectus clause 11.7.1. The list of post offices having facility for fee payment is available in the website.

Candidates allotted under SC/ST/OEC/Fishermen category and those having benefits as per G.O((MS)25/2005/SCSTDD, dated: 20.06.2005 and G.O(MS)10/2014/BCDD, dated 23.05.2014, and those candidates from Sreechitra Home, Juvenile Home, Nirbhaya Home are exempted from paying fee. However, if such candidates are allotted under Minority/NRI quota seats in Self-Financing Medical/Dental colleges, they will have to remit the fee as shown in the allotment memo and they will not be eligible for any fee concession.

Candidates who have an allotment can download the '**Data Sheet**' containing the basic details of the candidates by clicking the menu '**Data Sheet**' available in the home page of the candidate. The printout of this Data Sheet is to be produced before the college authorities at the time of admission.

Those candidates who have an allotment should join the course/college as per the allotment before **4.00 PM on 20.09.2023**. Those candidates who do not join the course/college allotted, within the stipulated time will lose their allotment as well as all the existing higher options in the stream to which the allotment belongs. If any vacancy exists in MBBS/BDS courses after the third phase allotment, it will be filled up through Stray Vacancy Allotment considering the options registered afresh for the stray vacancy allotment.

Candidates who get allotment in MBBS in Self-Financing Colleges should pay the fee fixed by the Fee Regulatory Committee for Medical Courses for the academic year 2023-24 (Fee structure is given in the website). As the fee for BDS course for the academic year 2023-24 is not fixed by the Fee Regulatory Committee, candidates have to pay the fee fixed for the year 2022-23 and the balance fee to be paid, in case if the fee to be fixed for the academic year 2023-24 is higher than that of 2022-23.

Stray Vacancy Allotment for MBBS & BDS Courses

- There will be fresh option registration for stray vacancy allotment.

- Data will be shared with the centre and the state after third phase allotment and if any candidate has his name in the list of allotted candidate, in either centre or state, then such candidate shall not be participated in the stray vacancy allotment.
- Candidates who joined the allotted seat in the third phase allotment are not eligible for participating in the stray vacancy allotment.
- Candidates who have been allotted seats in the third phase are not eligible for participating in the stray vacancy allotment.
- Candidates who exited the seat after the date prescribed by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations are not eligible for participating in the stray vacancy allotment.
- Candidates joined/holding a seat in the all India quota at the time of stray vacancy allotment as per the data shared by the central authorities are not eligible for participating in the stray vacancy allotment..
