## **NOTIFICATION**

## <u>KEAM-2025</u> <u>RESERVATION FOR DEGREE HOLDERS OF BUMS AND BSMS</u> <u>FOR MBBS COURSE & DOCUMENTS RELATED</u> <u>TO NRI CLAIMS</u>

As per KEAM 2025 Prospectus Clause 5.2.7 and 5.2.8 (i), 7 Seats and 4 Seats have been reserved in MBBS Course for degree holders in Ayurveda (BAMS) and Homoeopathy (BHMS) respectively (Total 11 Seats). But, now as per G.O(Rt) No.653/2025/H&FWD dtd 05/03/2025, degree holders in Siddha (BSMS) and Unani (BUMS) are also eligible for admission to the 11 MBBS quota seats earmarked for BAMS and BHMS degree holders.

Hence, in continuation to this office notification dated 20/02/2025, it is further notified that the degree holders in BSMS(Siddha) and degree holder in BUMS(Unani) can submit their respective documents including degree certificate, internship certificate, and registration certificate in support of claim, for MBBS quota seats, until **10/03/2025,5.00 PM**.

## NRI claim related documents

- Validity of Visa-equivalent documents indicating visa validity, such as Civil ID, Resident Permit, Resident ID, IQAMA, Electronic Visa Employment Pass, or Entry Visa may be considered.
- II. If any document attested by the Embassy/Consulate General of India

mentions visa validity, such documents may be considered.

III. If the sponsor's visa states 'Housewife' or 'Student' as the employment status, the corresponding Employment Certificate may be considered valid if it is properly attested.
