## <u>ALLOTMENT/ ADMISSION TO M.B.A (KMAT) COURSES - 2021</u> CANDIDATES CAN VIEW STATUS OF THEIR ONLINE APPLICATIONS

The candidates appearing for the Entrance Examination for admission to M.B.A Courses 2021-22 (KMAT) to be held at various centers in Kerala on 11.04.2021 (Sunday) can view their application status on the website <a href="www.cee.kerala.gov.in">www.cee.kerala.gov.in</a> from 31.03.2021 onwards.

The candidates have to enter their **Application Number** and **Password** on the page available after clicking on the link **KMAT 2021 - Candidate Portal**' of the above website to view the status of their application.

The application of certain candidates have some defects which may cause withholding of their admit cards. Those candidates can view the defects by clicking the 'Memo' link available in their home page. Such candidates are required to rectify the defects by uploading the relevant documents through the website www.cee.kerala.gov.in.

Candidates having defects in their photo, signature can upload photo and signature before **05.04.2021**, **3 pm**. Candidates who have any defects in their online application can view the defects by clicking the 'Memo' link available in their home page. They are required to rectify the defects by uploading the required images through the website <a href="www.cee.kerala.gov.in">www.cee.kerala.gov.in</a> before **05.04.2021**, **3 pm**. If the memo is related to the payment of application fee, the amount must be paid online through the 'K MAT-**2021 candidate portal**' on the above website before **05.04.2021**, **3.00 pm**.

Documents submitted by post/e-mail/fax will not be accepted for rectifying the defect under any circumstances.
