For each part (section) of the question set:

- The cancelled questions are excluded and the remaining questions are valued with 3 marks for each correct response and a negative mark for each incorrect response.
- The sum of the marks for the individual responses is multiplied by the corresponding correction factor, if applicable.
- Here, GENERAL ENGLISH and ARITHMETIC AND MENTAL ABILITY only have cancelled questions.
- For each candidate the total score for each of these sections is multiplied by the corresponding correction factor.
- the numerator of the correction factor is the total number of questions of the section and the denominator is the number of valid questions after discarding the cancelled questions.

- In the case of GENERAL KNOWLEDGE and APTITUDE FOR LEGAL STUDIES, the original scores are used as such as there are no cancelled questions in them.

The scores thus obtained for GENERAL KNOWLEDGE, GENERAL ENGLISH, ARITHMETIC AND MENTAL ABILITY and APTITUDE FOR LEGAL STUDIES are added together to get the final score of the candidate.
