ALLOTMENT TO LLM COURSES 2022 ONLINE OPTIONS INVITED

Centralised Allotment Process for admission to LL.M Courses in four Government Law Colleges and Private Self-financing Law Colleges of the State which have entered into seat sharing agreement with the Government for the academic year 2022-23 commenced on **09.12.2022**. All Candidates who have been included in the rank list for admission to LLM Courses 2022 can register their options online through the website **www.cee.kerala.gov.in**.

Candidates may enter their Application Number & Password in the link 'LL.M 2022-Candidate Portal' provided in the website **www.cee.kerala.gov.in** to log on to their home page. Then by clicking the menu item 'Option Registration', candidates can register their options online from **09.12.2022 to 13.12.2022, 10.00 AM**. The allotment will be based on the rank list, category list and the online options received and will be finalised on **16.12.2022**. Candidates who fail to register their options online will not be considered for allotment under any circumstances. Options forwarded to the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations by Email/Fax/Post/Hand delivery will not be processed or considered on any account for the allotment of seats. **The schedule for the allotment is given below:**

Annual Tuition Fee, Deposit amount, other fees for the LL.M Courses should be remitted in the allotted colleges at the time of admission.

Candidates who receive allotment should have attained the eligibility for admission as per Clause 6 of the Prospectus at the time of admission.

Documents to be produced at the time of Admission

- a. Candidate's Data Sheet.
- b. Allotment memo issued by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations.
- c. SSLC or any relevant school records/birth certificate/passport/other valid document to prove date of birth in original.
- d. Original Mark list and Pass Certificate of the LLB Examinations (all mark list)
- e. Transfer Certificate and Conduct Certificate from the institution where the candidate studied last.
- f. Four copies of recent passport size photograph.
- g. The applicant who is employed or trainee in Government/Quasi Government/Banks etc. shall, at the time of interview, produce a relieving order and a certificate of good conduct from the Head of the Institution where the candidate was employed.

- h. Candidate who passed their qualifying examination from Universities/Boards outside the state shall produce an "Eligibility Certificate" from the concerned university in Kerala, to the effect that the qualifying examination has been recognised by the University. The students opting for Law Colleges under various Universities in Kerala should have obtained the 'Eligibility Certificate' from the University concerned sufficiently before the submission of online options for allotment under Centralised Allotment Process (CAP).
- i. The student who qualifies from other Universities should produce migration certificate at the time of admission.
- j. Originals of all the uploaded documents/certificates (to prove nativity /reservation/fee concession).
- k. Any other certificates/documents required to be furnished as per the prospectus/notifications/allotment memo.

<u>Note:</u>

- 1. Candidates are advised to file options to the courses/colleges to which they are sure to join and continue studies if allotted, at the time of registration of options.
- 2. The candidates whose results in the rank list have been withheld due to defects in Nationality, Nativity can also register their online options for allotment. But the options submitted by such candidates will not be considered for allotment unless they upload the required documents through Candidate portal to clear the defects and release their ranks before 11.12.2022,2.00PM.
- 3. Candidates who do not take admission within the specified dates shall lose their allotment as well as their higher options. They will not be eligible for future online allotments, if any, under centralized Allotment Process (CAP)
