## <u>NOTIFICATION</u> <u>ADMISSION TO LLM COURSE-2022</u> <u>MOP UP ALLOTMENT PUBLISHED</u>

The Mop-up Allotment to the LLM courses in 2022 to fill up vacant seats in the Government Law Colleges and Private Self Financing Law colleges in the State having seat sharing agreement with the State Government is published on the website www.cee.kerala.gov.in. Mop Up allotment list is finalised after ensuring that no complaints have been received regarding the provisional allotment list published on 17.02.2023. The Mop up allotment has been prepared on the basis of the conditions stipulated in LLM Prospectus clause 16 and notification dated 14.02.2023.

To view the Allotment Result, candidates should log on to the 'LLM 2022-Candidate Portal' by submitting their Application Number and Password. Then, by clicking on the link 'Allotment Result', candidates can view their Allotment Results. It is necessary to take a printout of the Allotment Memo. The allotted candidates should report for joining at the allotted colleges from 20.02.2023 and before 22.02.2023, 3.00 PM, along with all required documents specified in the Allotment Memo as per Prospectus clause 18.

Candidates should remit the specified fees to the allotted college at the time of admission. Candidates belonging to SC/ST/OEC/Communities eligible for Educational concessions as is given to OEC/Candidate eligible for Fee concession G.O. (Ms) NO.25/2005/SCSTDD. as per Dated.20.06.2005/Children of Fisherman/Inmates of Sree Chitra Home/Nirbhaya Home/Juvenile Home are exempted from remitting tuition fees. All College authorities should approve the list of admitted candidates through the Online Admission Management System (OAMS) before 4.00 PM on 22.02.2023.

Course once allotted in the Mop-Up Allotment are final and cannot be changed further. If the candidates, who have already been admitted to LLM through previous phases of allotment by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations, get an allotment through the Mop up allotment, their current admission will stand cancelled. Candidates are liable to join the newly allotted seat. Surrender of seats after Mop up Allotment will not be permitted.

The registration fee paid for Mop-up allotment will be adjusted in the fee of the course if the candidate gets an allotment or else will be refunded after the end of counseling The registration fee paid for Mop-up phase of those candidates who do not join the seat allotted in Mop-up or stray vacancy filling allotment will be treated as penalty and will not be refunded. Candidates admitted to the course through previous phases of centralized allotment by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations who vacated the seat or availed of TC after the last date of option registration for mop-up allotment shall be liable for a penalty equivalent to the mop-up registration fee.

**Stray Vacancy Filling:** After the Mop up allotment, if any vacancies exist or arise, those vacancies shall be filled through the Stray vacancy allotment. For the Stray vacancy allotment, the options registered by the candidates during the Mop up round will be considered. Those candidates who are currently (as of the last date of mop-up option registration) holding seats and those candidates who are allotted/admitted to the courses through mop up/stray vacancy round allotment will be excluded from the further allotment process including Stray Vacancy Allotment. A detailed notification in this regard will be published later on the website.
