FIRST ROUND STRAY VACANCY ALLOTMENT - OPTIONS INVITED

The activities related to the First round Stray Vacancy Allotment to fill up the vacant seats that exist/arise after the vacant seat allotment for admission to LLM Course in the Government Law Colleges and Private Self- financing Law Colleges for the year 2025-26 has commenced.

The schedule for the allotment is given below:

27.12.2025	Option Registration starts
30.12.2025, 03.00 PM	Option Registration ends
Allotment and Institution Joining Schedule will be notified later	

The candidates who get allotment in this phase shall have to join the allotted college with all the original certificates as given in the prospectus clause 19 within the stipulated time to be announced by the Commissioner for Entrance and should remit applicable tuition fee, other fees and the deposits (if applicable) in the allotted colleges at the time of admission.

General Rules of Stray Vacancy Allotment:

Based on the following conditions, Candidates who have figured in the rank list of LLM Course 2025 published by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations and satisfy the eligibility criteria as per clause 9 in the Prospectus can register fresh options and participate in this phase of allotment.

1. Those who have already been admitted will not be eligible to participate in this phase and subsequent phases of allotments.
2. Those who have got allotment in vacant seat allotment will not be eligible to participate in this phase and subsequent phases of allotments.
3. Candidates already admitted who obtained their Transfer Certificate (T.C.) after **2:00 PM on December 22, 2025**, are ineligible to participate in this phase and any subsequent allotment phases.
4. Probable vacancies due to category conversions will also be filled up in the stray vacancy allotment based on the options in this stray vacancy allotment, hence candidates are advised to take into account probable vacancies also.
5. The seats received through stray vacancy allotment cannot be changed further at any instance.
6. Candidates who are allotted a seat in the stray vacancy allotment (irrespective of the admission status) will not be eligible for any subsequent allotments.
7. After the Stray Vacancy Allotment, if vacancies exist/arise, these vacancies shall be filled through second round Stray Vacancy Allotment. For this round, options registered by candidates during this round Stray Vacancy Allotment will not be considered.

8. Allotment shall be subject to the final order/affiliation/approval of the Govt./University concerned.

Vacancies remaining after the vacant seat allotment has been published in the website, **www.cee.kerala.gov.in**.

Registration Fees

Candidates who wish to register options in stray vacancy seat allotment will have to pay separate registration fees to the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations.

Exceptions in payment of registration fees

1. Candidates who paid the registration fee in previous allotment phases but do not hold an active admission as of December 22, 2025, at 2:00 PM (the deadline for free exit) are exempt from further payment.

2. Those who have already paid registration fees in vacant seat allotment round but do not have any allotment in vacant seat allotment are exempt from further payment.

Those candidates who wish to register options will have to remit registration fees of Rs.2000/- (Rupees Two Thousand only) to the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations. Candidates belonging to SC/ST/OEC category eligible for benefits as per G.O (Ms) No. 25/2005/SCSTDD, dated: 20.06.2005 and G.O (Ms) No.10/2014/ BCDD, dated: 23.05.2014 and those candidates from Juvenile Home, Nirbhaya Home, Sreechithra Home will have to remit Rs.500/- (Rupees Five Hundred Only) as Registration Fee. Registration fee has to be remitted by way of online payment. The registration fee of those candidates who do not get allotment will be refunded. If a candidate gets allotment and does not join within the stipulated time, the option registration fee will be considered as penalty and will not be refunded. Option registration fee of the candidates who quit the seats after taking admission will be considered as penalty and will not be refunded. Refund of option registration fee for the eligible candidates will be made only after the completion of allotment process and it will be notified.
