ONLINE MOP UP ALLOTMENT TO PG DENTAL (DEGREE)
COURSES, KERALA-2022
ONLINE OPTIONS INVITED

The activities related to the Online Mop Up Allotment to Post Graduate Dental courses-2022 in Government Dental Colleges and Private Self-financing Dental Colleges in the State is commenced from **10.11.2022**. This allotment will be conducted to fill up the currently available vacant seats and the seats expected to be released during the allotment process of the Online Mop Up round. Eligible candidates included in the Rank list published by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations can register their options online through the website **www.cee.kerala.gov.in** from **10.11.2022 to 14.11.2022, 10.00 AM**. Those candidates who are admitted in All India Quota seats are not eligible to participate in Mop Up allotment.

Candidates may enter their Application Number & Password in the link '**PG Dental 2022 Candidate Portal**' provided in the above website to log on to their home page. Then by clicking the menu item '**Mop-up Registration**' candidates can register their options online. The allotment based on the rank list and the online options received up to 10.00 am on **14.11.2022**, will be published on **15.11.2022**. Candidates who get allotment shall have to join the allotted colleges by paying the fees to the allotted college. The schedule of joining will be notified later.

The schedule for the allotment is given below

10.11.2022	Website opens for Option Registration/Rearrangement/ Deletion.
14.11.2022, 10.00 AM	Time for Option Registration/Rearrangement/Deletion ends
15.11.2022	Allotment Publication (Provisional)

Mop-up Registration Fee :-

There will be separate Registration fee for Mop-up counseling, for those candidates who have filed options in Mop-up phase. The registration fee amounting to the annual tuition fee of the seat opted, if opted only for government seats (Rs. 49,620/-) or an amount of Rs.1,00,000/- (Rupees One lakh only), if opted also for private self-financing colleges will be set as registration fee. Those candidates who have paid any Registration fee to the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations through previous rounds of counseling, they have to pay the balance amount as Mop up Registration fee. For SC/ST/OEC and other eligible candidates for fee concession, the registration fee for Govt./Private colleges will be , half of the above amounts respectively.

- The registration fee paid for mop-up allotment will be adjusted in the fee of the course, if the candidates gets an allotment or else will be refunded after the end of counseling.
- The registration fee paid for mop-up phase of those candidates who do not join the seat allotted in mop-up or stray vacancy filling allotment will be treated as penalty and will not be refunded.

Candidates allotted to courses, and who remit the fee/balance fee as prescribed, should take admission in the college/course allotted as per the schedule prescribed by the CEE. No extension of time for reporting to the college will be granted under any circumstances. The candidates are liable to pay admission fee as prescribed by the University at the time of admission.

Note:

1. Candidates who belong to SC/ST/OEC/Children of Fisherman/Inmates of Sri Chithra home, Nirbhaya home, Juvenile home are exempted from payment of fees.
2. Candidates who get an allotment in the Online Mop Up counseling will lose their current admission.
3. Those candidates who are holding All India Quota/Deemed/Central University seats as per the allotment of MCC will not be eligible to participate in this phase of allotment.
4. If any candidates (including SC/ST/OEC Students) discontinue the PG Dental course after joining the Mop-Up counseling shall have to pay liquidated damages as per prospectus clause 19.5. If a service candidate discontinues the PG Dental course after the Mop Up counseling shall have to pay liquidated damages as per clause 11.5

After the Mop-up allotment, if any vacancies exist or arise, those vacancies shall be filled through stray vacancy allotment, by considering the options registered by the candidates during the Mop-up round. Vacancies exist after the initial stray vacancy allotment, additional stray vacancy allotment may be conducted by forwarding list of eligible candidates to the colleges where vacancies exist and the allotment shall be done at

the college level based on the guidelines issued by the Commissioner for entrance Examinations at that time. The various list of candidates for the college level stray vacancy filling after the mop-up allotment will be prepared based on the options registered for the mop-up allotment process. So, candidates who intend to participate in the institution level stray vacancy filling should also participate in the mop-up allotment by registering fresh options for the mop-up allotment.

The allotment to Colleges / Courses will be subject to recognition of All India Regulatory Bodies / Affiliation from the Universities concerned.
