ORDER

As per the Government Order read as 1 st paper above, orders were issued approving the Prospectus and Deviation Statement for admission to the Post Graduate Pharmacy (M.Pharm) Course for the academic year 2025–26. The Director of Medical Education, as per the letter read as the 2nd paper above, has submitted a report proposing certain amendments to the approved Prospectus in view of the revised eligibility and admission criteria prescribed by the National Board of Examinations in Medical Sciences (NBEMS), New Delhi.

2. Government have examined the matter in detail and are pleased to amend and replace the following clauses in the Government Order read above as shown below.

Clause 5.1.1

The candidates including service quota candidates who qualified GRADUATE PHARMACY APTITUDE TEST (GPAT) in the year 2025, 2024 & 2023 conducted by National Board of Examinations in Medical Sciences (NBEMS), New Delhi / National Testing Agency (NTA), Noida are eligible for applying for Admission to the Post Graduate course in Pharmacy (M.Pharm) in the academic year 2025-2026.

Clause 9.1

A qualified candidate in *GPAT 2025/2024/2023* seeking admission to the courses should apply online through the website www.cee.kerala.gov.in of the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations.

Clause 9.2.1. Step 1: Registration

This is a one-time process. Candidate should provide *GPAT-2025/2024/2023* testing ID and Date of birth for entering the registration page. Date of birth must be same as that of *GPAT-2025/2024/2023* registration page.

Clause 9.3 Documents to be furnished at the time of admission before the Admitting authority.

Candidates should produce all the Original Documents at the time of admission.

- * First page of the printout of the Application Acknowledgement Page.
- *Proof for Date of Birth: Secondary School Leaving Certificate/Birth certificate/ Indian Passport.
- * B.Pharm Degree/Pass Certificate.
- * Score card of *GPAT-2025/2024/2023*
- * Transfer Certificate (TC) and Conduct Certificate from the Institution last attended.
- * Originals of all the Uploaded documents/certificates

Clause 11.1

The Rank list will be prepared on the basis of the GAPT Score obtained by the candidates in GRADUATE PHARMACY APTITUDE TEST (GPAT) 2025/2024/2023 conducted by National Board of Examinations in Medical Sciences (NBEMS), New Delhi / National Testing Agency (NTA), Noida. The category wise cut off qualifying marks, fixed for each category for the GPAT 2025/2024/2023 will be considered as the category wise cut off qualifying marks for the respective category for the year 2025. In case of a tie in GPAT score, the candidate (including Service Quota) with the higher marks for B Pharm (4th year marks / 7 & 8 semesters' marks) will be placed higher. If the tie still persists, the candidate greater in age will be placed higher.

Clause 12.1 AN OVERVIEW

The Centralized Allotment Process for all Seats in Government Colleges and Govt. Seats in Self Financing Colleges for which the allotment is made by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations, Kerala through a Single Window System (SWS). The allotments will be strictly based on the options exercised by the candidate, the rank list prepared for the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations based on the *GPAT score of* 2025/2024/2023 and eligible reservation(s) of the candidate and availability of seats.

Clause 13.1 Reporting at the College:

Candidates need to report for admission before the Principal/Head of the institution concerned only when the announcement regarding the same is made by the Director of Medical Education. He/she should report with the originals of the following documents (i to xii):

- (i) Allotment Memo received online.
- (ii) Fee mentioned in the allotment memo
- (iii) Certificate to prove date of birth.
- (iv) Transfer Certificate (TC) and Conduct Certificate from the Institution last attended.
- (v) Mark lists of all parts of B.Pharm Degree examination and Degree/Provisional Certificate (if applicable).
- (vi) Mark lists of 2nd, 3rd and 4th year of B Pharm course and Diploma in Pharmacy Certificate in the case of Lateral Entry candidates.
- (vii) Copies of the GPAT 2025/2024/2023 qualified score card.
- (viii) Eligibility Certificate from KUHS, in the case of candidates who have passed the qualifying examination from universities outside Kerala and other universities within Kerala.
- (ix) Migration Certificate, if applicable.
- (x) Undertaking as per Clause 21
- (xi) Pharmacist Registration Certificate issued by the State Pharmacy Council.
- (xii) Medical Certificate of Physical Fitness.

The Government Order read above stands modified to the above extent only.
