# NOTIFICATION ADMISSION TO POST GRADUATE DEGREE/ DIPLOMA COURSES IN AYURVEDA, KERALA 2023 CANDIDATES CAN SUBMIT ONLINE APPLICATION

### I. Applications are invited for admission to:

- a. Post Graduate Degree Courses in Ayurveda in the Government, Aided and Self Financing Ayurveda Colleges of the State.
- b. Post Graduate Diploma Courses in Ayurveda in the Government and Aided Ayurveda Colleges of the State.
- II. The titles of the PG Ayurveda Degree Courses are detailed in Annexure III and Annexure III (a) of the PG Ayurveda Degree Prospectus 2023. For the PG Ayurveda Diploma title of courses, candidates can refer to Annexure III of the PG Ayurveda Diploma Prospectus 2023.

## III. Participating Institutes

Post Graduate Degree courses are offered at Government Ayurveda Colleges in Thiruvananthapuram, Trippunithura and Kannur as well as Aided Ayurveda Colleges in Ollur and Kottakkal and other Self Financing Colleges. The Post Graduate Diploma Courses are available at Government Ayurveda Colleges in Thiruvananthapuram, Trippunithura, Kannur, and in Aided Ayurveda College at Kottakkal.

## IV. Eligibility for admission:

*Nativity*: The applicant should be an Indian citizen of Kerala origin. Non Keralite candidates are also eligible to apply for admission to PG Ayurveda Degree All India Quota seats available in the Self Financing colleges .

Age: No upper age limit is specified for admission to the course. In the case of Service Quota candidates, the age limit for Teachers Quota candidates should be 50, as on 31.07.2023 and that of Medical Officer Quota candidates should

#### be 46, as on 31.07.2023.

**Qualifying Criteria:** All candidates seeking PG (Ay) courses including Service quota in the State of Kerala for the academic year 2023-24 must have qualified for the National Eligibility–Cum Entrance Test for PG (Ay) Courses (AYUSH PGET) conducted by AIIA, New Delhi and should figure in the rank list prepared by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations. The selection of candidates for the seats reserved for the Medical Officer of the Department of I.S.M, the Teachers Quota and the candidate sponsored by the Lakshadweep Administration will be made on the basis of the rank obtained in the Entrance Examination conducted by the All India Institute of Ayurveda (AIIA) subject to satisfying the eligibility conditions. The minimum eligibility mark in the entrance test (AIAPGET 2023) shall be the 50<sup>th</sup> percentile in the case of General Category and that of SC/ST/SEBC Category shall be the 40<sup>th</sup> percentile. In respect of Differently Abled Candidates category, the minimum mark shall be at the 45<sup>th</sup> percentile for the General Category and the 40<sup>th</sup> percentile for the SC/ST/SEBC category.

#### **Academic Qualifications:**

Candidates should have passed BAM /Ayurvedacharya /BAMS from the colleges having NCIM recognition and the BAMS Degree of the Universities of Kerala or its equivalent degree recognized by the University of Kerala with 50% of marks for theory and practical separately in each subject. But exemption for minimum marks prescribed for admission for MD (Ay)/ MS (Ay) is granted to the students who have passed the BAMS/BAM examination before 1995 from the Universities of Kerala without 50% of marks for theory and practical. The cut off date for the completion of internship towards determination of eligibility for appearing in AIAPGET 2023 shall be 31<sup>st</sup> August, 2023. The dates indicated by the candidates in regards to 12 months Compulsory Rotating Internship i.e., starting date, completion date shall be treated as final and candidates will be required to submit the original Compulsory Rotating Internship completion certificate at the time of counseling. Admission will be given only on the production of Internship Certificate and Registration Certificate from the Medical Council constituted in this regard.

#### V. Mode of selection:

The Selection of the candidates shall be made from the rank list

prepared by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations, Kerala, on the basis of the AIAPGET 2023 rank list, subject to satisfying the eligibility conditions as mentioned in the prospectus.

### VI. *Submission of Applications and Application Fee*

All candidates, including Service Candidates seeking admission to the Post Graduate Degree/Diploma Courses in Ayurveda can apply online till **06.10.2023, 4.00 PM** through the website **www.cee.kerala.gov.in** of the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations by entering the required AIAPGET 2023 details and then the candidate should remit the required application fee by way of online payment. Candidate shall upload the candidates' photo and signature, as well as all necessary certificates and documents, after paying the required application fee.

Service Candidates, including teachers quota, should send their applications to the Director, Directorate of Ayurveda Medical Education, Arogyabhavan, MG Road, Thiruvananthapuram, before **1.00 PM on 06.10.2023**, by taking a printout of the online application and sending it along with a NOC (No Objection Certificate) and all necessary certificates. Medical Officers (ISM) should send their applications through their Controlling Officer (The Director, ISM Department) to the Directorate of Ayurveda Medical Education, Arogyabhavan, MG Road, Thiruvananthapuram, before **1.00 PM on 06.10.2023**. Service candidates need not send their documents to the Office of the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations.

## VIII. *Last date of Application* :

All candidates seeking admission to the courses should submit the online application along with uploaded Certificates/Documents mentioned in the prospectus before **4.00 PM of 06.10.2023**. Defective and incomplete applications will be summarily rejected. No correspondence will be undertaken in this regard. Candidates will be allowed, neither to include any information in the application form nor to submit any certificates/documents claiming

reservation or any benefits, after the submission of the application. No need to send the printout of the application or any documents to the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations.
