<u>NOTIFICATION</u> <u>ADMISSION TO PG AYURVEDA COURSES-2023 SECOND PHASE</u> <u>CENTRALISED ALLOTMENT PUBLISHED</u>

The Second Phase of allotment for admission to the PG Ayurveda Courses-2023 (Degree/Diploma) in the Government Ayurveda Colleges and Private Self Financing Ayurveda Colleges in the State is published. Allotment is finalised and published after addressing valid complaints received regarding Provisional Allotment list published on 02.11.2023. This allotment is based on the rank in the Kerala State Merit List & Category list and on the options rearranged/deleted and confirmed by the candidates within the stipulated time.

The allotment result is available in the 'Candidate Portal' on the website of the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations www.cee.kerala.gov.in. To view the allotment result, candidates should log on to the 'PG Ayurveda 2023-Candidate Portal' by submitting their Application Number and Password. Then by clicking the link 'Allotment Result', candidates can view their allotment results. The Allotment Memo and Data Sheet are available in the Candidate Portal. Candidates are advised to take copies of the Allotment Memo and keep it for future reference, as the Memo will not be available in the Portal once the allotment process is over.

The allotted candidates should report physically for joining at the allotted colleges from **06.11.2023 to 09.11.2023**, **3.00 PM** with the Allotment Memo, Data Sheet and the required documents specified in the Allotment Memo and Prospectus. The prescribed fee should be remitted at the allotted college during admission.

Candidates belonging to SC/ST/OEC/Communities eligible for Educational concessions as is given to OEC/Candidate eligible for Fee concession as per G.O. (Ms)NO.25/2005/SCSTDD. Dated. 20.06.2005, Children of Fisherman/Inmates of Sreechitra Home/Nirbhaya Home/Juvenile Home are exempted from remitting tuition fees.

All College authorities should approve the list of admitted candidates through the Online Admission Management System (OAMS) before **4.00 PM on 09.11.2023.**

Note: Those candidates who do not join the colleges allotted within the stipulated time will lose their allotment.
