**ADMISSION TO PG MEDICAL COURSES-2021**  
**ONLINE MOP UP REVISED ALLOTMENT (PROVISIONAL) PUBLISHED**

The Online Mop-up Allotment to the P G Medical (Degree) Courses-2021 to fill up vacant seats in the Government Medical Colleges in the State, Regional Cancer Centre (RCC), Thiruvananthapuram and Private Self Financing Medical colleges is published in the website [www.cee.kerala.gov.in](http://www.cee.kerala.gov.in). **The Mop up Allotment Result published earlier stands cancelled and the Revised Allotment Result (Provisional) being published now by excluding candidates who got allotment in All India Mop-up allotment as per the guidelines issued by DGHS is valid.**

To view the allotment result, candidates should log on to the **‘PG Medical 2021 – Candidate Portal’** by submitting their **Application Number** and **Password**. Then by clicking on the link **‘Revised Allotment Result’**, candidates can view their allotment result. Any candidate having complaints regarding the list published shall send the same as e-mail to [ceekinfo.cee@kerala.gov.in](mailto:ceekinfo.cee@kerala.gov.in) before 3.00 PM of 28/4/2022. The final allotment list will be published on 28.04.2022. The Allotment Memo issued earlier is cancelled herewith and the **Revised Allotment Memo** will be available after the Revised Allotment Result(Final) is published. The date of joining has been revised as 29/4/2022 to 30/4/2022, 4.00 PM.

Course once allotted in the online Mop-up Round shall be final. Surrender of seats after allotment in the online Mop-up Round will not be permitted. Those candidates who do not join the seat allotted through Mop-up Round or vacate the seat admitted after Mop-up Allotment will be liable to pay liquidated damages as stipulated in clause 12-2.1 of the Prospectus for admission to PG Medical Courses 2021. Those candidates who vacated their seats admitted through previous allotments conducted by Commissioner for Entrance Examinations after 26/4/2022 will also be liable to pay liquidated damages.

In case vacancies exist/new vacancies arise after Mop-up Allotment, these will also be filled in the subsequent phase i.e., Stray Vacancy Filling Round based on the options given for the Mop-up allotment. The guidelines for Stray Vacancy Filling Round will be notified later.
