ADMISSION TO PG MEDICAL COURSES-2025 FIRST PHASE CENTRALISED ALLOTMENT PUBLISHED

The First Phase Centralised Allotment to PG Medical Courses for the academic year 2025-26 in the Government Medical Colleges, RCC Thiruvananthapuram and Private Self Financing Medical Colleges in the State has been published in the website www.cee.kerala.gov.in. The allotment is based on the rank in the Kerala State merit list published by Commissioner for Entrance Examinations and online options filed by the candidates. The allotment has been published after addressing the valid complaints received from candidates against the provisional allotment published on 27.11.2025. The allotment result is available in the above mentioned website of the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations. In compliance with the interim order in WP(C) No. 35067 of 2025, one seat in General Surgery under the service quota of the Directorate of Medical Education has been reserved and, therefore, has not been included in this allotment.

To view the allotment result, candidates should log in to the 'PG Medical 2025 - Candidate Portal' using their Application Number and Password. By clicking on the 'Allotment Result' link, candidates can view their result. Candidates who have received an allotment should take a printout of the Allotment Memo from the home page.

The allotted candidates should report for joining the allotted colleges from **01.12.2025 to 07.12.2025, 4.00 PM** along with the required documents (as per prospectus clause 10.1.22) specified in the Allotment Memo. The fee should be remitted at the allotted college at the time of admission. The allotted candidates who do not take admission in the respective college within the specified time will lose his/her present allotment as well as all the CEE/257/2025-TA2 I/487092/2025

options and such candidates will **NOT** be considered for second phase allotment. Also a candidate who vacates the seat joined in phase I will not be considered for phase II allotment.

The list of participating Medical Colleges in the allotment process and the tuition fee applicable to each college have been given in the notification dated 06.11.2025 published on the website.

Candidates who have claimed SC/ST reservation and whose caste status is under scrutiny by KIRTADS have been provisionally considered for allotment. The allotment/admission, if any, of such candidates shall be purely provisional and subject to final verification of their caste status. Also those candidates, who have uploaded sworn affidavit of sponsor in case of memo for defect rectification in visa validity expired/expiring for NRI claim, have been included provisionally for first phase allotment. Their Allotment/admission in NRI quota seats, if any, will be cancelled if they fail to submit the document as prescribed within the stipulated time and will not be considered for NRI seats in further allotment.

All the college authorities should approve the list of admitted candidates through Online Admission Management System (OAMS) at **5.00 PM on 07.12.2025.**
